Evidence of significant amount of water running down trail for next .04 miles. Some waterbreaks on trail but needs more attention. (1)</li> <li>• Trail parallels Summit Road at .13 miles with a series of telephone pole waterbreaks until it reaches road.</li> <li>• Trail ends at Summit Road at .17 miles.</li> </ul>				
<b>MINOR&amp;MAJOR PROBLEM AREAS</b>		(1) The water runs down this trail almost unimpeded. Need to review and decide proper location for waterbreaks and/or waterbars to slow water and get it off the trail.
