TRAIL LANDMARKS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Trail starts at Rt 28, at firegate, no parking and 'no wheeled vehicle' signs, heading N on approximately 18" tread, with very wide right-of-way and plastic yellow gas company markers. Very wet area. • Iron culvert, 16", L to R, at 50 yds. • Hawk Hill Trail Marker 3005 crosses at 100 yds. • Old stonewall on either side of right-of-way at 326 yds. • Bouncing Brook Path Marker 3011 cross trail at 340 yds. • Hemlock Bound Foot Path and Slide Hill Trail Marker 3013 cross trail at 729 yds. • Skyline Trail crosses with rect. blue markers at 816 yds, heavy drainage coming from E entry of Skyline, resulting in waterflow and very wet trail. • Trail traverses over a very wet boggy area at this point, but the tread is high enough to stay dry. • Iron culvert, 18", R to L, at .65 miles. Clean. • Iron culvert, 18", R to L, at .81 miles. Water flowing, clean. • Iron culvert, 18", R to L, at .85 miles. Water flowing, clean. • Trail ends at Braintree pass path, unofficial Marker 3022 at .92 miles.
