Trail was created in 2013 as a singletrack path following the contours of the hill to prevent erosion. The trail replaced the Buck Hill Summit Path which was heavily eroded. • .44 mi Trail crosses the old Buck Hill Summit Trail. Old trail has been brushed in. there is some evidence of water flowing down old trail but it is not adversely impacting NEMBA Trail. • .51 mi Trail crosses stonewall. • .63 mi Trail arrives at ledge area with nice views of Boston. • .74 mi Trail ends at Skyline Trail near a large rock on right. Need signage to prevent bikes on Skyline Trail.
