The trailhead is 40 feet west of the intersection with Swamp Trail (intersection is not indicated on the DCR map). The trailhead is marked with two large blocks of granite one of which has a large drill hole in it. The treadway leaves the trailhead at road width. New bog bridge approximately 18 feet long at .12 miles Fowl Meadow Path crosses Burma Road at intersection marker 6005 at .13 miles and continues at road width. Sewer to the right of the treadway at .21 miles. Sewer to the right of the treadway at .29 miles. Unnamed path leaves on left at intersection marker 6009 at .33 miles. Map shows this unnamed path as a wide road however significant brushing would be needed if road width is desired. Sewer to the right of the treadway at .36 miles. Concrete cistern to right of treadway at .44 miles. Well point to the left of the treadway at same location. The Fowl Meadow Path ends at the Indian Path intersection at .44 miles on the south bank of the Neponset River.
