TRAIL LANDMARKS		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Trailhead leaves from intersection marker 6101 at road width immediately after a broken DCR gate and well point to the right of the treadway. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Note: Access to this area can be from Burma Road or Royall Street. For the purpose of this assessment, the trail was accessed via Royall Street as follows; • Trail is accessed via an unnamed footpath noted on the DCR map that leaves from the north side of Royall Street. The footpath is directly across the street from the Compushare Company parking area at 250 Royall Street. The trailhead, near a blank white sign on a tree, is obscure (1) • Blowdown 274 feet. • Blowdown 291 feet. • This unnamed footpath intersects the Skyline Trail at 423 feet. At this point another unnamed footpath intersects with Skyline. This path leads to the cul-de-sac at the end of Royall Street. • Turn left (west) at this intersection and follow the Skyline Trail, crossing a stone wall at .14 miles. • The footpath continues and crosses a concrete culvert drainage ditch at .20 miles. • The footpath ends at an abandoned asphalt road noted on the DCR map at .24 miles. • Asphalt road narrows at .46 miles and becomes overgrown. At .52 miles there is a large blowdown which requires crawling under or bushwhacking around (2). Road becomes gravel. • A dirt road leaves on the right to the trailhead at .57 miles at a broken DCR fire gate. • Green Hill Path begins at intersection 6101. • The Orchard Trail leaves on the right at road width at intersection 6102. • Brushing needed. • Unnamed path (presumably Field Path) enters on the left at .23 miles. Trailhead is obscure and is at footpath width. Intersection marker 6103 could not be located in the field (3). • The Orchard Trail enters on the right at intersection marker 6104 at .30 miles at road width. • The Swamp Trail enters on the left at intersection marker 6105 at .45 miles at road width. • Spur trail to the Swamp trail enters on the left at .47 miles at road width. • Unnamed path leaves on the right at intersection marker 6106 at .50 miles at road width. • The Green Hill Path ends at what is presumably the park boundary 					

	<p>marked by a “No Hunting” sign and two rusted metal stakes approximately 2 ½ feet tall marked with yellow ribbons at .62 miles. Just past this boundary an unnamed road width path (continuation of Fowl Meadow Path not shown on DCR map) enters from the left.</p>
