TRAIL LANDMARKS		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The Indian Path Trail leaves from the northwest end of the Fowl Meadow Path. It heads south along the bank of the Neponset River until it intersects with Burma Road. This is a wonderful walk along the river ascending and descending slightly as it follows the contours of tributaries flowing into the Neponset River. Commuter rail follows the north side of the river. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • This trail also continues north of the Fowl Meadow Path following the Neponset River however is not shown on the DCR map. • Treadway crosses a small streambed at 230 feet. 3' wide. Currently dry. • Treadway crosses a small streambed at 370 feet. 3' wide. Currently dry. • Narrow, rogue footpath connecting to Burma Road enters from the left at 1.07 miles. • The Indian Path leaves left from the footpath following the riverbank at 1.1 miles and continues on to Burma Road. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The small footpath continues to follow the river for another .2 miles and ends at a small stream just before the route 95 underpass. • Indian Path ends with its intersection with Burma road at 1.15 miles.
