TRAIL LANDMARKS		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Trailhead leaves from the south side of Cosmos Path at Marker 6830. This trail shares the same treadway as a section of the Green Dot Loop and is blazed with green dots. Treadway begins ascending again at road width. • Unnamed path leaves on the left to the summit of Little Blue Hill at .10 miles at footpath width. • Unnamed path leaves on the left to the summit of Little Blue Hill at .12 miles at footpath width. • Treadway continues to ascend and enters an area with a large rock outcropping and viewpoint at .14 miles. There is a granite bench at this point dedicated to Augustus Hemmingway. <p style="text-align: center;">The following inscription is on front of bench: Augustus Hemmingway 1855 – 1931 He lived on this land. He loved these woods.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">The following inscription is on back of bench: Exempt from Public Haunt Finds Tongues in the Trees Books in the Running Brooks Sermons in the Stones And Good in Everything</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Treadway begins to descend at footpath width. • Unnamed path leaves on the left to the summit of Little Blue Hill at .15 miles at footpath width. • Treadway crosses open slabs at .19 miles. These can be difficult to traverse if ice is present. • The Moulton Path ends at the Skyline Trail Marker 6891 at .25 miles.
