R to L. Rotted and ineffective. Replaced with a new stone enhanced grade reversal, which needs additional dirt and to be cleaned. (1) • Treadway reaches a height of land at 150 feet. • Treadway enters an intersection at intersection marker 5381 at .16 miles. An unnamed link path leaves on the left (NE) to the Three Pines Path as the Fire Trail continues to the right heading southeast. • Treadway reopens to road width at .19 miles. • The Fire Trail ends with its intersection with Hemlock Road at intersection marker 5384 at .26 miles.
