Route:		Path running North-South along western side of the lower St. Mortiz pond and between Skyline and the northern end and Water Pipe Lin at the southern end.					
Recent Weather:		Overcast, in the upper 30's. Some recent light rain.					
TRAIL LANDMARKS		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • This recently rediscovered/restored foot path starts at Skyline with two wood bars as stairs. • Large tree trunk (1.5 feet in diameter) lies across path at 90 feet. Elevated above ground by a few inches, so not trivial to step over. • Greenbriar growing near trail between 100-120 feet, currently not affecting passage. Small white pine trees in this area will need pruning/removal. • Tree trunk (8 inches in diameter) lies across path at 200 feet. Easily stepped over. • At 0.13 miles there is an old rock fire pit. • At 0.19 miles an old rotten trunk lies across trail. • At 0.20 miles the trail takes a sharp right turn – may continue to need branches piled to block hikers from walking straight in gulch near Pipe Line. • At 0.20 trail meets the Water Pipe Line.
