Trail heads south at footpath width. • Trail reaches Wampatuck Rd at .11 miles. Two boulders mark the trail. Without crossing the road, the trail reenters the woods at a location marked by two more boulders at .13 miles. • At .14 miles blowdown in trail, rotting log on ground, can be stepped over, 15". (1) • At .15 miles blowdown in trail, rotting log on ground, can be stepped over, 20". (2) • At .17 miles blowdown in trail, rotting log on ground, can be stepped over, 10". (3) • Trail dead ends at .18 miles. A narrow unnamed path ascends steeply to the right from the Shawmut Path.
