At Intersection marker 1092, North Skyline and Wildcat Notch Path intersection, the waterbar is continually being overrun due to a collapsed culvert on Wildcat Notch Path. Clay pipe in treadway is collapsed. Recommend replacement or rolling dip be installed. I saw some nice universal access waterbars in Switzerland that could be adopted here. We should review.
