Cleaned all waterbars on trail (about 15) and side ditches from near Marker 1175 up the hill past the cutoff for Eustis Trail. Reworked old exposed wooden waterbar just above Marker 1175 by adding rocks and dirts to allow safer passage for mountain bike riders. Also improved series of three waterbars just below Marker 1114 by adding rocks to create more effective grade reversal. Most of the water on the trail was just flowing over the existing waterbars.

Work Remaining:

Need to keep an eye on series of three grade reversals to make sure water flows correctly. Same with grade reversal created at old wooden waterbar near cutoff to Eustis.

There is also a set of four wet spots after Bartol heading west. It would be great to fill these with crushed stone and then crown with dirt.
