Raked out and reshaped the following drainage structures, including the outflow ditches (distances from Wolcott Path):

Grade reversal at 200 ft (formerly a wood waterbar) Grade reversal at 266 ft (formerly a rolling dip) Ledge waterbar at 367 ft Rolling dip at .17 miles

Checked cuverts at .48 and .49 miles. Both were clear of branches and other obstructions. Raked leaves out of entry and exit areas of ditches.

Minimal brushing and branch clearing was needed.

Total Hours (# of people x hours worked): 4.50

Work Remaining:

Convert rolling dip at .17 miles to a grade reversal.

Ask the State agencies for permission to build at least two new grade reversals north of .17 miles. One is needed at the bottom of the hill on the trail just north of .17 miles. At least one other drainage structure would be helpful on the gradual downgrade or flat part of the trail, where water drains onto the trail from a large rock ledge to the east. Water tends to pool in the trail in this area.
