Raked out the following drainage structures, including the outflow ditches, to remove leaves and pine needles, shoveled out stones from these structures, and reshaped the structures and ditches (distances from Wolcott Path):

Grade reversal at 200 ft (formerly a wood waterbar)

Grade reversal at 266 ft (formerly a rolling dip)

Ledge waterbar at 367 ft

Rolling dip at .17 miles

Checked culverts at .48 and .49 miles. Both were clear of branches and other obstructions. Raked leaves out of entry and exit areas of culverts.

Limited brushing.

Made two small notches in the tiny berms near the largest mud pit, in hopes of allowing water drainage from the mud pit. This area is quite flat, but water drains into the trail from Hancock Hill.

Total Hours (# of people x hours worked. Use # of people x 3.5 for trail maintenance events): 2.50

Work Remaining:

It would be helpful to bring in some gravel to build up the crown of the trail at the mud pit(s), and also use the gravel to cover the exposed part of the corrugated plastic pipe that makes up the top of the south culvert (north of intersections 1178/1180).
