Walked Sawcut Notch from Shea Rink to the notch. Moved several blowdowns from trail (windy last night & today. Large blowdown at Sawcut & Short Path in drainage ditch, Couldn't move it out.

**Work Remaining:**

Path in good shape. The waterbar at Short & Sawcut handled a lot of water, but it all went into the drainage ditch. Bittersweet vine is growing wild there also. It needs to be cut out, it's clogging up the ditches. The erosion at Wampatuck road going down to the pond needs to be fixed before someone gets hurt. The rut is about a foot deep. A swale at the small side foot path (Green Dot trail) may be enough, depends on how much run off is coming from the road. I know that the small footpath runs like a stream during heavy rains. May have to do some thing further up on it. This probably a good work project for Nov. Would need to get ok from Ale on swales to be installed. This also runs across the pipe line down towards the pond. The swales may prevent this.

The trail is in good shape. Furnace Brook and Pine Tree Brook are running again.
