Just south of Wampatuck Rd - section about 100 yards

**Work Completed (Please be specific with location of work. Note hazards & potential hazards addressed if applicable):**

1) Installed rock swale where the tar apron from Wampatuck Rd ends. Water from road cut two erosion channels down the length of the trail to the pipeline. Swale collects water and diverts off the trail. Filled in some of the erosion south of the swale.

2) Created wide grade reversal at the intersection with Green Dot Trail to collect any water that gets past rock swale and/or water travelling down Green Dot. Cleared outflow area into woods to enhance flow.

3) In the woods to the West of Skyline, there is a storm drain outlet under Wampatuck Rd that directs water toward a culvert under Green Dot. The water did not flow properly and was flowing onto Green Dot. Removed leaves and other debris from trench and dug out a small trench to direct water toward culvert and cleared bypass area for high flow times. Removed debris from culvert.

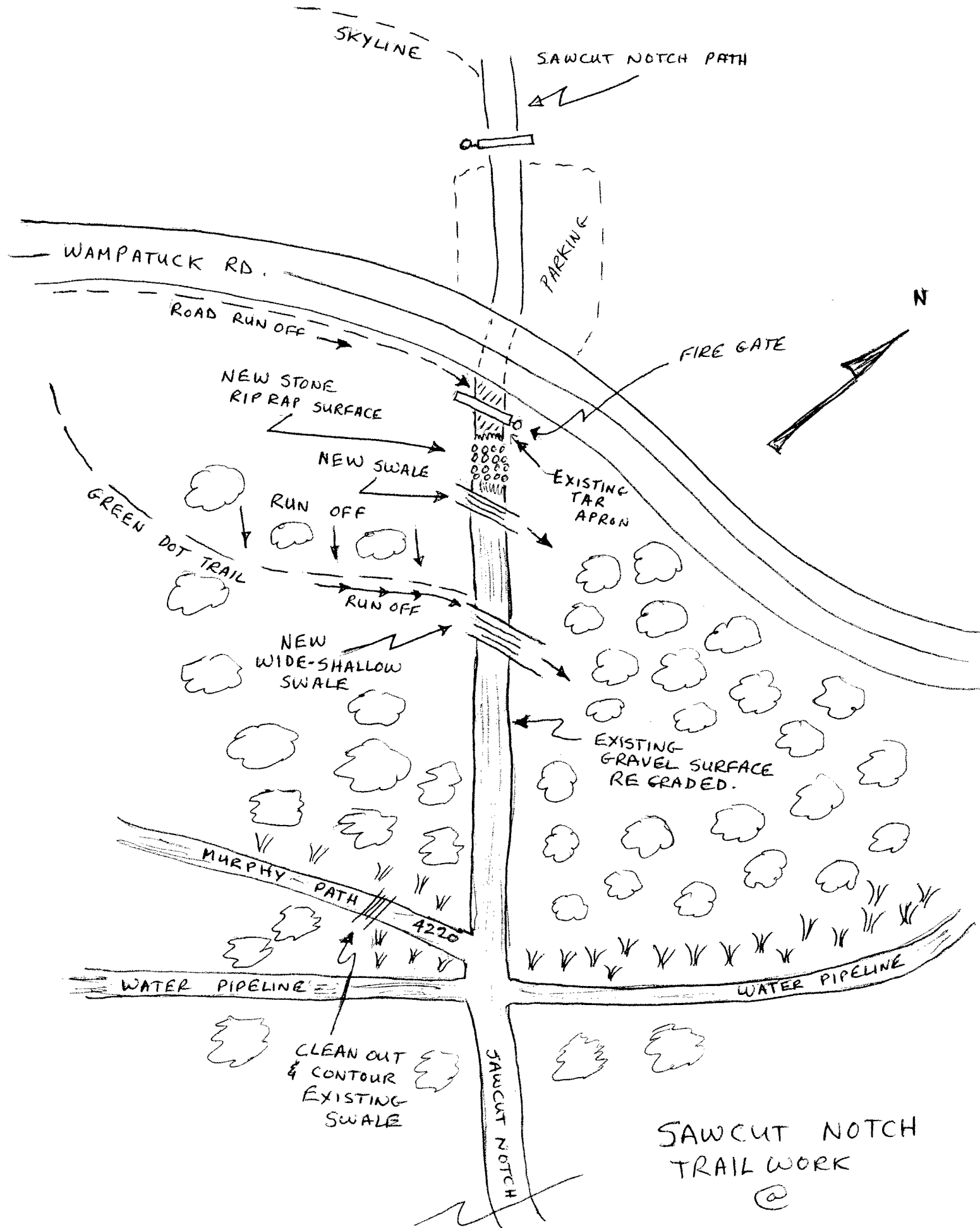
**Total Hours (# of people x hours worked):** 31.50

**Work Remaining:**

Need to keep an eye on the whole area. The swale will need to have fill added between the stones as it settles. Also need to keep an eye on the area in the woods to make sure the water flows properly. Trail still needs to have erosion channels regraded. There was some crushed stone left out there and that needs to be deployed. There is still a need to clean out the swale across Murphy Path.

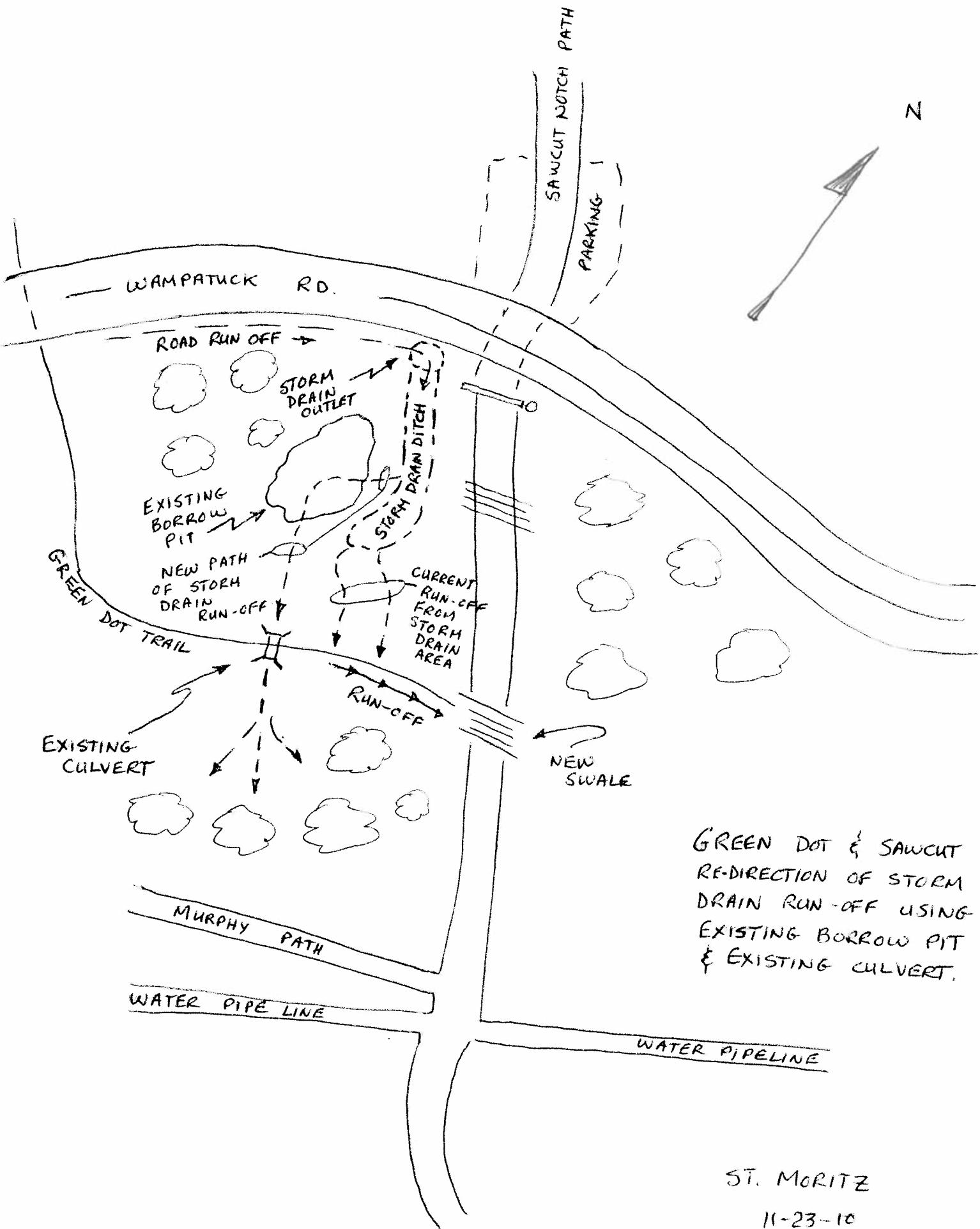
