Brushed section of trail. Heavily overgrown area. Took down several small trees, many were dead. A lot of bittersweet and poison ivy vines, witch hazel, hornbeam and a huge amount of greenbriar were removed. The trail bed is very eroded in one area for some 200 feet. There is still clean up needed, much of which is causing the water to travel down the trail.

Work Remaining:

There are 2 large blow downs, (maybe 18" dia.), laying across the trail. Need a chainsaw, (or a whole day if using hand saws). The rest of the trail from the stream to the CCC Camp was not completed.
