About 50 yards from intersection with pipeline near Marker 4155.

There is a small stream that crosses the Skyline Trail. Removed leaves, branches and rocks from stream for 20 yards upstream and 50 yards downstream. Also added some rocks to the trailbed to get trail users out of the mud leading up to the stream.

Work Remaining:

Still need to improve the waterflow across the trail to keep it from flowing onto another trail heading downhill. There is a tree in the middle of the stream and the water should be pushed more toward the rock slope which would help keep it off the other trail. Also could add more rock on the opposite side of the stream to get people out of that mud. Should also follow the stream downhill to confirm it can flow across the other trail about 150 yards downhill. Should add more dirt to fill in the cracks between the rocks that were added.
