Cleared and removed debris from old wooden steps from 30's winter carnival that define the northern terminus of the path where it intersects the skyline. Removed smaller blow-downs with hand saw, lopped overhangs, removed brush and raked to define route of the original path.

There is a fallen tree crossing the path with trunk too thick for hand-saw, requires chain saw to clear.
