There is one downed tree across the trail, ~12" and too big for our pruning saws. It's on the ground and not difficult to step over. There are also many LARGE trees across one of the trails leading out to the neighborhood.

Other comments (areas of concern, wildlife sightings, trail markings and signage condition, need for re-route, possible encroachment):

Sign at 4048 states "300 yards to CCC Camp", however that appears to be the distance down the, now abandoned, Sassaman Trail, not the distance by still open trails, which is MUCH further.

Also, the trail, as it approaches 4048, is somewhat eroded and could use one or more waterbars to get the water off the trail
