Walked Murphy path heading north from 4202 to 4220.

1. Half way up Murphy Path where it meets the Water Pipeline, cleared back grasses that were encroaching onto the path.

2. Approximately 300 yards south of the intersection of 4220, a blowdown had fallen across the path, approximately 6" diameter, I dragged this to the side of path. Nothing else needs to be done.

Work Remaining:

200 yards north of the intersection with Ski Jump Path, a large trunked blow down, approximately 2ft diameter, has fallen across the path, it needs to be removed. People are walking around it creating a boot leg path approximately 10 yards in length. Picture provided to Dexter.

Other comments (areas of concern, wildlife sightings, trail markings and signage condition, need for re-route, possible encroachment):

There is large amount of graffiti in the form of writing covering a rock on the east side of the path between 4202 and intersection with Obbatinewat Path. More graffiti is on a rock at the intersection of the skyline ad Murphy Path.
