

Little Blue in Fowl Meadow Section

Hike # and title - #6000-1: Little Blue in Fowl Meadow Section

Type and difficulty of trail – Easy to moderately difficulty with some elevation

Distance - 5.87 miles

Elevation – ~572 feet

Parking and starting point – Park at the commuter lot on Route 138, south of the Trailside Museum near trail marker #6900.

Description – This loop takes you up Little Blue Hill. While the view is mostly obstructed by trees, you will have views of Great Blue from the summit and find a little bench at 6880 with an inscription. You'll also enjoy flat wooded paths. For experienced hikers, this route will take about 3 hours. To use the map below, you hike 'segment 1,' which brings you to segment 2. The last segment, 32, will bring you back to your car. The segments marked -2- or if short .2. mean that they are an out-and-back. You'll hike to the end and return. On the below map, some examples of these dead-end trails that you need to back-track to continue, include 2, 5, 6.
