Hike # and title - #4000-1 - Sawcut Notch Path in Quarries Section

Type and difficulty of trail – Mostly flat wooded terrain with some rolling hills.

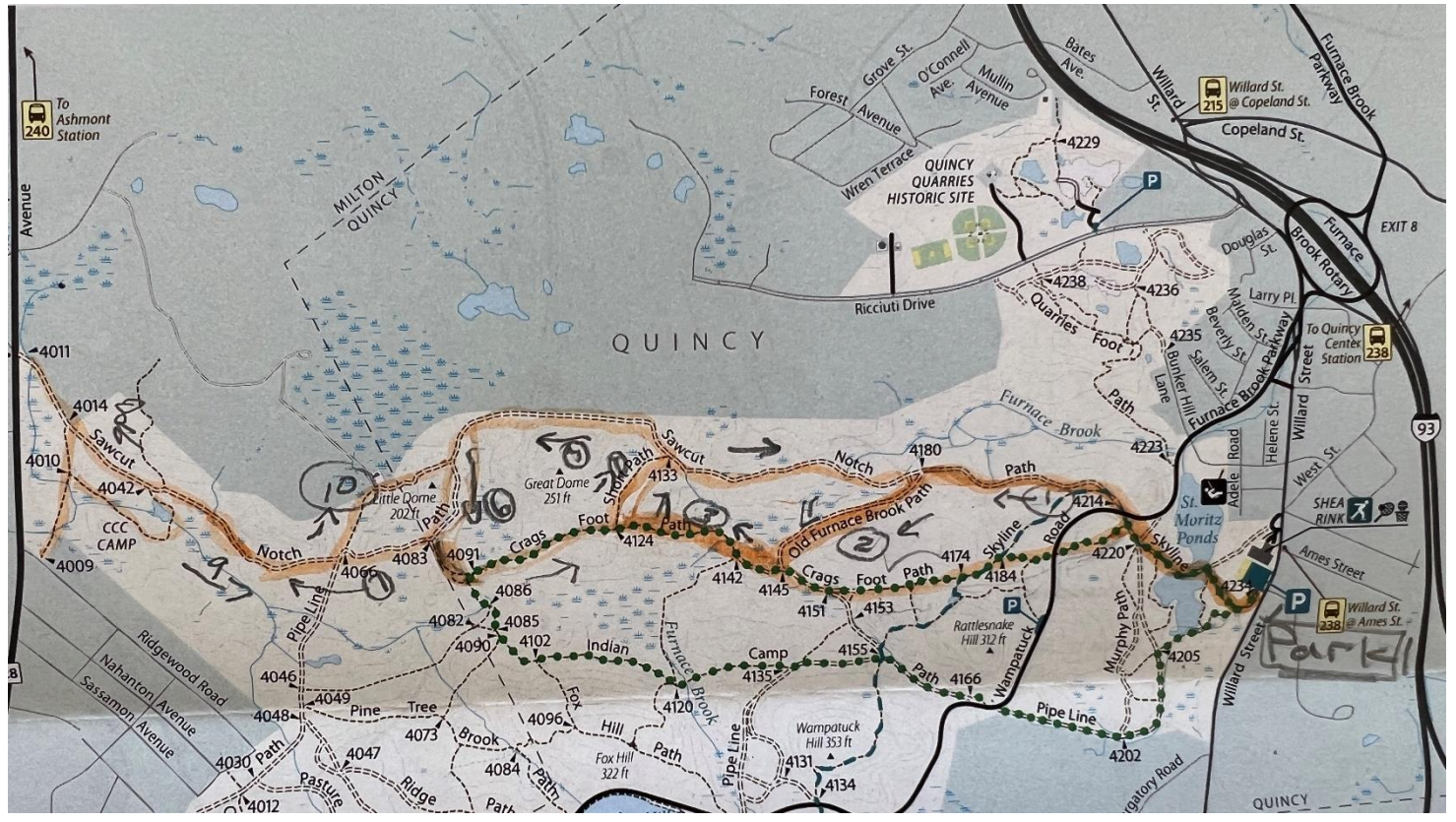
Distance - Approximately 4.5 miles

Elevation –

Parking and starting point - Park at Shea Rink, 651 Willard Street, Quincy

Description – On this route, you'll explore mostly level, quiet forest paths. You'll walk to the former Civilian Conservation Corps site (with ruins and an interpretive sign), and weave your way between the Craggs Foot Path and Sawcut Notch Path to cover the trails in the northern part of this section. *See notes on next page.*

Notes on Sawcut Notch in Quarries Section

Park at Shea Rink, 651 Willard Street, Quincy

Follow Skyline between ponds to Wampatuck Road.

Follow Sawcut Notch Path and turn:

- Left 4180 on Old Furnace Brook
- Right at 4145 on Craigs Foot Path
- Right 4142 on Short Path
- Left at 4133 on Sawcut Notch Path and continue to 4083

Continue past 4066 to 4011

Then backtrack to 4014 and continue to 4009

Follow back to 4010 and take a right

Take the time to check out the former CCC camp historic site and interpretive sign, as well as the vernal pool, tucked in the forest before you hit Sawcut Notch again.

Take a right at 4042 on Sawcut Notch

Take a left at 4066

Right near Little Dome

Take a left at 4091 to follow the Green dot Craigs' Foot Path

Right at 4133 on Short path

Take left at 4124

Right at 4180

Left at 4145

Continue on the Green dot trail to where you started at Shea Rink.
