<b>TRAIL LANDMARKS</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Trailhead leaves the North Skyline trail on the right near the summit of Hemenway Hill, Marker 1150.</li> <li>• Trail is somewhat obscured as it scrambles over the summit ledges into scrub.</li> <li>• Geocache box 19 located on right at 100 feet.</li> <li>• Trail is a narrow path.</li> <li>• Spur trail leaves on right to Hemenway Hill Path east at 434 feet.</li> <li>• Hemenway Hill Path Marker 1154 crosses at .10 miles. No mountain bike sign below it.</li> <li>• Trail continues as a narrow path, hard to follow at some points.</li> <li>• Spur trail to nice lookout on left at .47 miles.</li> <li>• Large fenced in cistern in stream on left downhill at .50 miles and trail crosses stream over stepping stones.</li> <li>• Jeffries Trail ends at Marker 1182 at Base Path at .52 miles.</li> </ul>
