Can be stepped over. Downed limbs and debris in and over the treadway at .14 miles. 6" dia. Center section of the E trail leaves on the left (NW) at road width at .25 miles. This treadway leads back to the farmhouse and will be assessed separately at the end of this assessment. E Trail continues east at road width with overhead bn at .25 miles.
