TRAIL LANDMARKS	<p>Trail starts out approx. 48" wide, white pine sapling-lined at the intersection with Bouncing Brook Path Marker 3151.</p> <p>751 yds. trail enters left (possibly East Hemlock Bound Trail)</p> <p>.71 mi trail turns right at large blowdown on side of trail</p> <p>Narrow trail heads R into the Southern end of the Great Cedar Swamp</p> <p>.80 mi. trail ends at intersection with Cochato Path</p> <p>Note: Old assessment had end of trail continuing along Rt 93 fence to Laurel Path. This has been changed to end at the new trail (Cochato Path). Flooding on Cochato is a seasonal problem. When it is flooded, it is not passable without wading thru water up to two feet deep. Fence has been repaired so it is no longer possible to pass thru on other side of fence. There was flooding on the day of the assessment.</p>
