TRAIL LANDMARKS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Trailhead is located on the south side of Chickatawbut Road at the Chickatawbut Overlook. Treadway is footpath width. The trail is part of the Yellow Dot Loop. There is an informational kiosk at the trailhead. There is a granite post marked Chickatawbut Overlook. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Parking is available at the trailhead. • Trail starts uphill at a series of stone steps beginning at 30 feet. • At 326 feet, the trail passes a stone pavilion, constructed by the Civilian Conservation Core (CCC) between 1934 and 1935. • At 350 feet, the return trail from the Yellow Dot Loop enters. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The return trail continues for 400 feet to intersection with Sassaman Notch Path. • At 200 feet down this trail, there is water flowing under the trail, L to R, but there is no evidence of a culvert. • At 386 feet, the trail passes an observation tower constructed by the CCC. • Trails ends at intersection with Slide Notch Path at .21 miles. Yellow Dot Loop continues to the right.
