Trailhead is approximately 5/8 of a mile north of route 93, exit 5. Turnoff parking available for approximately 3 vehicles. Trail is blazed with blue rectangles, Sbd 2/3 of the way into treadway at 190 feet. Needs to be moved (2 people) or cut back. Pipeline path crosses at 265 feet. Graffiti on a blue blaze on tree to the right of the treadway when reentering woods at 450 feet. Graffiti is bootleg 3014 intersection marker not shown on map. Water runoff from Pipeline Path and Hawk Hill running into the treadway covering the full width of the treadway with 2 inches of water. Flooding continues from the intersection at 450 feet through .16 miles. Possible extended bog bridge location. (1) (photos sle1 and sle2) Bn at .12 miles.
