TRAIL LANDMARKS	<ul> <li>Trailhead located on Hillside St at parking pull-out. The two trail "tails" depicted on the map are obscure. A wider, more obvious trail leads 100 feet straight from the street to the concrete dam at the pond. The dam is about 25 feet long and three feet high. There is a concrete pit in the middle of the dam that connects with a culvert which directs water under Hillside St. The pit is filled with debris and probably blocked. (1)</li> <li>The loop around the pond closely follows the shore and is quite narrow. Trail is primitive and is only suitable for foot traffic. Some scrambling over rock outcrops is required.</li> <li>Heading counterclockwise, the trail continues around the pond. Shortly after leaving the dam, a wider, unmarked trail goes uphill, away from the pond.</li> <li>At .26 miles, unmarked trail comes in from the right. Smaller rogue trails also enter from the right.</li> </ul>
