- Blazed lbd on left at .8 miles. Needs to be cut back as it extends into the treadway and blaze needs to be relocated. 18"dia, chainsaw work.
- Dark Hollow Path crosses at .82 miles and uses the same treadway for approximately 50 yards. Trail is blazed with green dots with white triangular blazes pointing north.
- Skyline leaves the Dark Hollow Path on the right at .83 miles.
- Bn at .84 miles with downed tree limbs. Bow saw and lopper work.
- Treadway enters an area of moderate runoff at .84 miles. Possible bog bridge location. (3) (Photo attached SLE01).
- Treadway enters an area of moderate runoff at .87 miles. Possible bog bridge location. (4)
- Bn at .88 miles.
- Bn at .92 miles. Additional blazes in this direction would be helpful here as route finding becomes challenging. (5)

- Unnamed path crosses at intersection marker 2117 at 1.0 miles. Blazed with white triangles pointing south. Blue rectangular blaze labeled KCE with design noted as trail reenters footpath.
- Treadway passes Whale Rock on right at 1.13 miles.
- Deer Hollow Path crosses at intersection marker 2141 at 1.17 miles.
- Bn at 1.18 miles.
- Trail begins ascending Buck Hill at 1.25 miles with bn.
- Trail enters an area of minor erosion at 1.27 miles. Rkw steps extend from here through 1.28 however 2 additional Rkw wb and dt running L to R above the steps would improve the erosion issue in this area. (6)
- Bn at 1.33 miles.
- Abandoned rwb at 1.37 miles needs to be dug out and dt.
- Unnamed path crosses at 1.39 miles.
- Treadway crosses the summit of Buck Hill at intersection marker 2165 at 1.41 miles.
- Unnamed path leaves on the left at 1.42 miles.
- Large cairn to left of treadway as the crossing the Buck Hill summit continues at 1.44 miles.
- Trail begins the descent of Buck Hill at 1.45 miles.
- Unnamed path leaves on the right at 1.45 miles.
- Rkw wb at 1.46 miles w/ bn. L to R. (New)
- Trail descends through an area of minor erosion however what appears to be new wbs in this area are addressing.
- Rkw wb at 1.47 miles w/ bn. L to R. (New)
- Rkw wb at 1.48 miles w/ bn. L to R. (New) Needs better dt on right.
- Rkw steps begin at 1.49 and continue through 1.52 miles with nice retaining walls. Loose rock needs to be removed.
- Buck Hill Path crosses at 1.52 miles.
- Unnamed path crosses at intersection marker 2210 at 1.63 miles. (May be an extension of Buck Hill Path.
- Forest Run Path crosses at 1.68 miles w/ white triangular blazes pointing north.
