TRAIL LANDMARKS		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Comment from 2008 assessment—"Although sections of the Field Path are navigable, it appears to me that this trail has seen very little use, no maintenance and I would consider it abandoned for all intents and purposes. A huge amount of maintenance would be required to restore this trail to what is represented on the DCR map." • In 2008, the trailhead at intersection 6102 was accessible. That is no longer the case as the area is blocked by extensive blowdowns and briar thickets. This attempt at assessment began .23 miles north of intersection 6101 on the Green Hill Path. A trail enters from the left, presumably where intersection 6103 should be located (marker missing). (1) • Trail starts at footpath width and then widens to road width. • The trail is faint and overgrown. At .11 miles it effectively disappears. (2) • Remnants of paths appear here and there. • A bushwhack through blowdowns and briar thickets (using map and compass) resulted in rejoining the Green Hill Path 130 feet north of intersection 6102.
