TRAIL LANDMARKS		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The Fowl Meadow Path trailhead is located at the end of an unnamed road width path at the reservation boundary, 20 feet north of the Swamp Trail trailhead. The trailhead is marked with two large blocks of granite one of which has a large drill hole in it. The treadway leaves the trailhead at road width. • Standing water crosses the treadway at .12 miles with a 2 section bog bridge in need of repair. (1) • Fowl Meadow Path crosses Burma Road at intersection marker 6005 at .13 miles and continues at road width. • Sewer to the right of the treadway at .21 miles Labeled 4.16 with orange paint and marker with a green stake. • Sewer to the right of the treadway at .29 miles Labeled 8.01 with orange paint and marker with a green stake. • Unnamed path leaves on left at intersection marker 6009 at .33 miles. Map shows this unnamed path as a wide road however significant brushing would be needed if road width is desired. • Sewer to the right of the treadway at .36 miles Labeled 11.39 with orange paint and marker with a green stake. • Bn at .40 miles. Limbs in treadway. • Cement cistern to right of treadway at .44 miles as well as a well point to the left of the treadway. • The Fowl Meadow Path ends at the Indian Path intersection at .44 miles on the south bank of the Neponset River.
