<b>TRAIL LANDMARKS</b>		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Map seems to indicate it is a loop but it is two separate exits from Sumner Path. The trailhead is pretty discreet but can be discerned with a good eye. Trail is a pretty narrow footpath that could use some brushing to keep it passable.</li> <li>• At 147 feet, narrow footpath leaves trail on the left.</li> <li>• At 375 feet, trail gets a little wet spot from a dry brook and sticks had been placed across spot to keep travelers out of the mud.</li> <li>• At 498 feet, the trail passes a dug-out area on the right. The edges are very high (over twenty five feet) and there is probably about two feet of water in the center.</li> <li>• Narrow footpath to left at .13 miles, trail narrows, could use some brushing.</li> <li>• Trail ends back at Sumner Path loop at .19 miles.</li> </ul>
