Trailhead in located .6 miles north of the Green Dot loop intersection marker 5343. Treadway is road width. Bn leaving trailhead. Small downed limbs to be cleared. Bow saw. Treadway narrows to 5 feet at 100 feet with bn as treadway begins ascending. Pine boughs. Bn at 340 feet as treadway narrows to footpath width. Bn at 430 feet as treadway continues to ascend. Small downed limbs to be cleared at .14 miles. Bow saw. Bn from .15 through .21. Pine boughs. Bn at .24 miles. Pine boughs. Bn at .25 miles. Pine boughs. Bn at .27 miles. Pine boughs. Unnamed Path Crosses at intersection marker 5330 at .3 miles. Bn at .31 miles. Blue diamond blaze to the right of the treadway at .32 miles. Sbd crosses treadway at .34 miles. 3". Carry off w/bn. Treadway opens to road width at .39 miles. No name Post ends with its intersection with the Ponkapoag Trail at intersection marker 5311 at .51 miles.
