TRAIL LANDMARKS		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Trailhead is located and leaves from a fire gate on the south side of Middle Street at road width, .15 miles from the west side of High Street. Trailhead leaves immediately following the abandoned Metro Parks Maintenance Support Unit (MSU) building. Bn immediately entering treadway. Downed limbs. Unnamed path leaves on the left at road width at 120 feet. Side and overhead bn at 175 feet. Pine boughs. Bn at 260 feet. Pine boughs and downed limbs. Bn at 340 feet. Pine boughs. Bn at 380 feet. Pine boughs. Bn at 510 feet. Debris in treadway. Treadway continues to parallel the abandoned Metro Parks fencing on the right. Treadway narrow with bn at .12 miles. Bn from .12 through .14 miles. Sbd crosses the treadway at .14 miles. 3" dia. Carry off. Bn at .15 miles to maintain road width. Bn at .19 miles. Unnamed path enters on left at .2 miles while another leaves on the right at .21 miles into the Metro parks area. Paths are road width. Middle Road continues southwest at road width while ascending. Middle Road enters the Pipeline at .29 miles and crosses to intersection marker 5422 at .32 miles, At this point Middle Road turns into footpath width. Middle Road continues west as an unnamed path leaves on the left at .39 miles. Middle Road ends at a highway fence 50 feet east of route 24 north at .45 miles. Highway fence has been knocked down by a lbd. (1)
