TRAIL LANDMARKS		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Trailhead leaves southwest from Skyline Trail about 265 feet from Shea Rink Marker 4234. Treadway is footpath width. Trail is also part of the Green Dot Loop. • At 200 feet, Winter Carnival Path leaves on right. • At 204 feet, trail crosses a three section footbridge of 60 feet in length. Bridge is constructed of 2" x 6" boards about 3 feet long and is in great shape. • At .12 miles, large concrete culvert located on right. Structure allows water to pass over pipeline and consists of one large rectangular culvert about three feet wide with metal bars and a 16" culvert pipe. • At .13 miles, trail joins the pipeline and turns left at Marker 4205. Marker is not official marker but a handmade one. Trail at this point widens to road width. • At .21 miles, 16" concrete culvert runs under trail and over pipeline. Water runs R to L. • At .23 miles, unnamed trail leaves on right. • At .24 miles, 16" concrete culvert runs under trail and over pipeline. Water runs R to L. • At .27 miles, 16" concrete culvert runs under trail and over pipeline. Water runs R to L. • At .30 miles, stone catch basin on right with no outlet. • Trail ends at Murphy Path trailhead at Marker 4202 at .35 miles. (1)
