First one captures water from a sewer grate on Wampatuck Road and is 6" concrete. Second one is 16" concrete and carries water under Wampatuck from other side of road.</li> <li>At .14 miles, trail crosses Wampatuck Road.</li> <li>At .16 miles, trail passes three large rocks and a granite marker for Quarry Trail and reenters woods. Culvert inflow located on right side of trail (as noted at .14 miles).</li> <li>At .19 miles, Shawmut Path leaves left at triangle, Quarry Trail continues right.</li> <li>At .24 miles, trail joins Skyline Trail at Marker 4184 and heads left up the hill. At intersection, there is a stone enhanced grade reversal L to R.
