TRAIL LANDMARKS	<ul style="list-style-type: none">Trailhead is located on the south side of the Skyline Trail .02 miles south of Wampatuck Road at a five-way intersection with the Pipeline at intersection marker 4220. Trailhead leaves from this intersection on a treadway to the right (west) of the pipeline road. Treadway is road width. Intersection marker 4220 could not be located. (1)<ul style="list-style-type: none">There is no parking at the trailhead. Trailhead is accessed by way of the Skyline Trail. The Skyline Trail is accessed from the Shea Rink parking area with Murphy path leaving on the left at .33 miles.Runoff in the treadway just leaving the trailhead.Bn at 250 feet. Briars need to be cutback to maintain road width.Treadway enters into the Pipeline at an unnamed path on the left at .16 miles.Murphy Path continues, leaving the Pipeline at road width on the right, paralleling the Pipeline heading due south.<ul style="list-style-type: none">Bn at .21 miles. Downed limbs in the treadway.Treadway turns right around a small-unnamed hill at .23 miles.Unnamed path leaves on the left at .29 miles.Unnamed path leaves on the left at .33 miles at road width.Downed limbs into the treadway at .33 miles.Bn at .41 miles.Murphy Path ends with its intersection with the Pipeline at intersection marker 4202 at .41 miles. Intersection marker is unofficial and is magic marker on a 4x4 trail marker with a green dot. (2)
