A makeshift 3' x 4' flag attached to a 20' sappling pole was erected on the south side of the Skyline, about 30' off the trail near Eliot Circle. I called DCR headquarters to determine if it was "legal". Maggi Brown indicated that she had noticed it earlier in the week and was planning to take it down since it was not legal. I removed the flag and pole and gave the flag to her. It was made using white muslin cloth and had a 6" red stripe running its full length centered. Judging by the traces of red paint on the trail, it was painted on site. The red paint did not stick and was flaking off.
