Cleaned culverts (4 total (2 clay)). Corrected run out area's on 2 culverts (no pitch). Picked up rubbish, brushed back overhangs.

Intersection 1215 (foot path) receives run off from a swale across Border Path. The swale goes directly to the head of the foot path off Border.

Total Hours (# of people x hours worked): 17.50

Work Remaining:

At least two (possibly 3) steel culverts across Border need to be replaced. May need machinery as the culverts are too high and the area is very boney. Don't know if it's possible to dig deep enough manually. One is somewhat of a hazard to users as it projects above the treadway.

One of the culverts cleaned out has a collapsed head wall. We could not find the opening although it does flow well. Will need steel bars to work on the headwall as the rocks are large.
