2 culverts, 2 waterbars just north of Five Corners, 5 large granite blocks should be reset into the bank of the drainage ditch/dry brook bed near fence to Trailside Museum not only functionally but aesthetically. Also 2 large rocks should be relocated that are blocking leaf build up in streambed when water is flowing.
