Raked out the following drainage structures, including the outflow ditches, to remove leaves, pine needles, and stones, and reshaped the structures using a shovel (distances from Wolcott Path):

- Grade reversal at 200 ft (formerly a wood waterbar)

- Grade reversal at 266 ft (formerly a rolling dip)

- Ledge waterbar at 367 ft

- Rolling dip at .17 miles

Checked culverts at .48 and .49 miles. Cleared leaves and small branches from culverts, and their inflow and outflow areas. This time there was enough material to mine from the outflow ditches to use for covering the exposed part of the plastic culvert pipe at the top surface of the more southerly culvert.

Cleared branches from the trail.

Brushing and pruning of vegetation.
