- 1) Add stones and improved existing grade reversal (R to L from the east) just east of Marker 1140 (noted as .73 miles in assessment).
- 2) Added new grade reversal with stones (R to L from the east) just before existing waterbar (noted on assessment at .70 miles).
- 3) Cleaned two grade reversals and one waterbar further to the east of debris (noted on assessments as .57 , .60 and .65 miles).

**Work Remaining:**

- 1) There is a waterbar just before Marker 1140 (noted as .75 miles on assessment) that could be cleaned out a bit but it pushes water onto Eustis Path. Hopefully, the structure just up the hill from here will keep water from flowing down to the waterbar.
- 2) There is a waterbar at .70 miles that has an outflow that heads uphill so it is unlikely to be fixed. A new structure was added just uphill of this structure so hopefully, that will make the structure at .70 miles unnecessary.
