Checked culverts at .48 and .49 miles north of Wolcott Path. Cleared leaves and small branches from culverts, and their inflow and outflow areas. Mined sediments from the outflow ditches of the culverts to cover the exposed top surface of the southernmost culvert.

Cleared branches from the trail.

Raked out the following drainage structures, including the outflow ditches, to remove leaves, pine needles, and stones, and reshaped the structures using a shovel (distances from Wolcott Path):

Ledge waterbar at 367 ft

Rolling dip at .17 miles

Added three rocks to the downslope end of the ledge waterbar, where some rocks had been displaced.

Limited brushing.

Minimal litter removal.
