We cleaned the two culverts at the start of the section of the Skyline Trail (near Hillside Street), did extensive brushing over the entire length of the trail, removed a few blowdowns & installed the rock steps in the wet area near the intersection with Dark Hollow Path(not wet now, but wet in winter and spring), cleared debris there and created a channel for the water to flow out. Also cleared loose rock off the trail on the ascending/descending portion of Buck Hill, to make conditions safer for hiking.

Possibly clean culvert at the Rt. 28 intersection, though the advance field notes given to us suggest that may be a state highway work crew responsibility. Chainsaw a large blowdown that could block water flow moving off the trail at the location where rock steps were installed near the Dark Hollow path intersection.
