There is a large tree (18 to 24 inch diameter) that is uprooted on one side of the trail and has fallen onto the upper branches of a tree on the other side of the trail. The fallen tree is about 15 feet above the trail and doesn't seem in danger of falling to the ground at this point. The tree is about 0.25 miles north of the intersection of Forest Path and the Skyline Trail.
