Cleaned out all grade reversals on my section of Burnt Hill Path, removed minor debris from trail, cut some branches that wind had broken and left obstructing trail. Someone had apparently been there ahead of me and cleared a considerable amount of pine windfall off the trail in various places. I cleaned that up a bit, but most work had been done.

Work Remaining:

About 150 feet up the path from the 2092 marker there is a large fragment of a tree that is obstructing the path, and which will require a chain saw to clear. The trail is passable for foot traffic, but would be difficult for a horse or bike.
