Initial assessment by trail adopter Barry Young. Started at Royal Street and worked north towards 6850. There is a significant amount of trash by Royal Street entrance which will be picked up next visit, approximately 30 minutes required. Also, this spur from the street to 6850 require some minor hand pruning. I did some this visit, but more required, approximately 30 minutes. There is land survey work in progress in this area along a stone wall which appears to be a boundary wall to a private parcel east of the K-path from Royal Street to just beyond 6850 with the line marked by orange survey flag. The trail from 6850 to 6800 is wide and in good condition. The trail from 6800 to 6670 narrows a bit and could use some minor hand pruning, but overall is in good condition.
