Gently brushed trail from St. Moritz to the Notch. Brushed wild rose bushes hanging over trail just north of the Notch.

The water control work done at the Notch is working perfectly. There has been no over runs of drainage ditches. There is still water coming off Short Path. I looked at it while it was wet, I think a small swale or dip across Short path perpendicular to the cut thru path in the triangle area from Sawcut path to Short Path would take care of it. I think we originally suggested a waterbar, the dip might be easier to sell to DCR.

Removed a blow down limb from Sawcut where the pipeline crosses near the pond. It was blocking most of the trail. Picked up rubbish (not much).

Work Remaining:

It would be wonderful to get some gravel into the Notch area now that the treadway is stable. Should pitch that to DCR.
