Walked path heading south from skyline trail to where it intersects with the water pipeline path.

1. Picked up a small amount of trash,
2. Cleared some overhangs with loppers,
3. Removed saplings growing among the stones of the firepit,
4. Rebuilt cairn at entrance with the Water pipeline path.

Work Remaining:

50 yards from intersection with the skyline path is a low lying area that becomes flooded during heavy rainfall. A drainage ditch, or other remediation, needs to be built to allow drainage in the southern St Moritz pond approximately 20 yards to the east of the path. This would be a good trail maintenance project (approximately 4 hours x 4 people. I've provided pictures of flooding to Dexter.

Other comments (areas of concern, wildlife sightings, trail markings and signage condition, need for re-route, possible encroachment):

Approximately 100 yards south of the intersection with the skyline path is a rotten tree trunk that has fallen across the path, approximately 2ft in diameter, it is easily stepped over.
